MBC's 23rd July tourney has 44 boats in competition

Forty-four boats set out at dawn on Friday morning to take part in the two-day Marshalls Billfish Club 23rd Annual Tournament, but it was slim pickings at that evening's Uliga dock weigh-in, with the only highlight of the day being the 362-pound billfish brought in early by Team Blue captained by Timothy Anok. The fish won Anok the Majuro Mayor's Trophy.

Saturday morning was a different story, with boats calling in catches every hour or so and club officials (wearing fashion passion rain coats made of garbage bags) having a busy time of it.

The wahoo division in the Bank of Marshall Islands-sponsored tournament was taken out by Team Dragon (Kyle Aliven) with a 29-pounder, and the barracuda class by Marlynn (Robert Momotaro, 38 pounds). Lady Lu (James Bing) is listed in the score sheet as winning the mahi-mahi division, but as his fish was just four pounds, we're not sure what bragging rights that wins him.

Of interest to all anglers was that no-one brought home a qualifying tuna (the biggest was a 37-pounder caught by Ronnie's Kirtake), meaning that a few thousand buckeroos in registration and sidebet money is now laying around the club's coffers waiting for a carry-over competition.

A novelty of the weigh-ins was newcomer Marilyn, a very healthy looking plywood billfish created by Darrin Haaversen and used to signify a

tag-and-released fish. Over the weekend, six boats won the right to pose with the cute creature.

Also posing alongside the lucky fishermen (and one woman) was the beautiful Miss Billfish, Isabella Silk. This lovely lady so impressed club officials there was talk by the end of the weekend that she should be invited back to be the Miss All-Mike in early September. This would be a first, but if Billy Roberts has any say in it, Isabella will be the All-Mike 'bella.

At the end of fishing on Saturday, a string of boats rafted up alongside the dock with the fisherfolk downing beers and telling one outlandish tale after another. Lorraine K's Larry Hernandez: "I saw the reel was going overboard, so I dived over with it, catching it miraculously before it hit the water..."

Bit of BS, we reckon, but actually Larry is a lucky lad as during the day he was hand-over-handing in a big fish when the beast made a dash for freedom: "My thumb, my thumb" he screamed up to Cap'n Kenneth as the line wrapped around his digit and tightened and tightened... "Your what? Your what?" came the reply. But Larry survived ... as did his thumb.

Then there was the tale of the guy who tossed out the team's luckiest lure of the year ... only to discover it wasn't tied on. Whoops!

Eventually the talk slowed and the boats peeled away into the night, the skippers and crews eager to catch a few hours sleep before the big Sunday picnic.

Next day and it's time for the banquet and awards ceremony poolside at the Marshall Islands Resort.

Emceeding the event were newly-returned Ben Graham and MEC head honcho Billy Roberts, who managed to twist a few laughs out of the crowd, which included a number of VIPs including President Kessai Note.

Another 316 pounds of fishy flesh and Bwiji Aliven would've had him. But it was not to be and on Saturday champion fisherman Cap'n Ronnie Reimers just squeaked in to take out the prestigious President's Cup for the sixth time in his illustrious fishing career.
